## **QUESTION 5**

Complete the conversation in the way outlined in brackets. (Do NOT translate the English directly into Spanish.)

While waiting to board a plane at the airport, Sandra engages in conversation with a fellow passenger.

SANDRA	¡Qué horrible tener que esperar tanto tiempo!
PACO	(He says that he agrees and that he can't wait to get to Sydney.)
SANDRA	Ah, yo también voy para Sydney. Acabo de pasar tres semanas en Madrid.
PACO	(He asks her what she was doing in Madrid and where she is from.)
SANDRA	Soy australiana. En Australia estudié el español por dos años y vine a Madrid para practicar el idioma.
PACO	(He asks her for her impressions of Madrid and tells her that she speaks Spanish very well.)
SANDRA	Me encantó Madrid. Es una ciudad de contrastes con aspectos modernos y tradicionales. Estoy deseando regresar. ¿Y cuál es el propósito de su visita a Sydney?
PACO	(He says that he has been learning English at university and that he is going to Australia to practise and learn about the culture.)

SANDRA	¿Y por qué Australia que está tan lejos? ¿Por qué no Inglaterra?
PACO	(He says that he has already been to England and that he has heard a lot of good things about Australia.)
SANDRA	Sí, Australia es un país hermoso y Sydney es una ciudad muy bonita. ¿Cuánto tiempo piensa estar en Sydney?
PACO	(He says that he is only planning to stay two weeks because the hotel accommodation is very expensive. He then plans to visit some friends in Melbourne before going to Queensland for a few days.)
SANDRA	Yo vivo con mi familia en una casa muy grande en el centro de la ciudad. ¿Por qué no pasa esas dos semanas con nosotros?
PACO	(He says that it would be a great idea; that way he can practise English and she can practise Spanish. However he doesn't want to cause her any problems.)
SANDRA	Ah, ¡ningún problema! Para mí sería un placer.
PACO	(He thanks her very much and says that he is going to make a call to cancel his hotel accommodation.)
