# **QUESTION 5**

Complete the conversation in the way outlined in brackets. (Do NOT translate the English directly into Spanish.)

At the Train Station		
USTED	(Excuse yourself to the employee and ask for his help.)

USTED	(Say that you went for a walk, had a drink and when you came back the train had gone. Ask if there is another one today.)

EMPLEADO	Pues, entonces, hay un tren que sale para Casona dentro de una hora, a las once en punto. En Casona se hace cambio para Dorado y de allí a Montes en autobús.
USTED	(Ask if you have to wait a long time for the train at Dorado.)
EMPLEADO	Hay una espera de casi una hora, pero es la única solución si quiere llegar a Montes hoy día.
USTED	(Say that there is nothing else you can do. Ask where you can buy a ticket.)
EMPLEADO	Ahí, en cualquier ventanilla.
USTED	(Thank the employee. Say that he has been very kind.)
EMPLEADO	De nada. ¡Buena suerte y buen viaje!
