 H1 – red, serif font (e.g. Times New Roman), largest (36 point), bold, 2.1.3
 centred 2.1.4
 H2 – dark green, sans-serif (e.g. Arial), bold, italic, smaller (14 point), left
 aligned
 P – black, sans-serif (e.g. Arial), smallest (12 point), justified
 Save the stylesheet and attach it to each web page as you create it.
- 3 Using a suitable software package, create a new home page 3.1.1
RTHOME.HTM which has a heading at the top, menu options on the left
 and a text/graphics area on the right. It should look like this:

- 4 Set the page heading for the home page to **Rootrainer Trees** in style H1. 2.1.4
- 5 Place the contents of **RTMENU.TXT** down the left of the page to create 3.1.2
 the menu options in style H2. 2.1.4
- 6 Create a hyperlink for the item *Indigenous Roots* to point to the file 3.2.1
RTROOTS.HTM, which should open in a new window called **EXTERNAL** 3.2.2
- Note that the web page you have linked to is not yet complete.
- 7 In the text/graphics area on the right create a table which has 4 rows and 4.1.1
