

French Syllabus for 13+ Entry

All candidates applying for entry to Year 9 are required to take a 45 minute French paper, which is exactly the same for scholarship and non-scholarship candidates.

The examination will consist of:

- a) Questions to answer in French.
- b) Grammar exercises.
- c) A short essay or 2 paragraphs on different topics (100-150 words).

The examination will test the following knowledge:

1. Verbs

- The present and perfect tenses.
- Regular verbs in -er, -ir, -re, avoir, être.
- Some common irregular verbs: aller, dire, écrire, faire, mettre, prendre, venir, voir.
- Asking questions and replying in affirmative and negative.
- Simple commands.
- Recognition of common reflexive verbs in everyday use and the ability to use them.

2. Nouns and Adjectives:

- Simple nouns and adjectives, including colour, in common use relevant to the topics listed.
- Candidates will be expected to use mon, ma, mes; ton, ta tes, and to recognise other possessive adjectives. Cardinal numbers, dates, time, weather, seasons.

3. Interrogative Words:

- Qui? Qui est-ce qui? etc.
- Que? Qu'est-ce que? etc.
- Où?
- Quand?
- Combien?

- Comment? Comment est?
- A Quelle heure?
- Quel âge?
- De Quelle couleur?
- Pourquoi?
- 4. Articles and Prepositions:
 - le, la, l', les.
 - un, une, des.
 - use with prepositions eg, du etc, au etc.
- 5. Topics:
 - Home
 - Travel
 - Personal details
 - Hobbies, games and pastimes
 - School
 - Food and eating
 - Holidays
 - Town and Shops
