1 Read the passages and answer the questions.

You are advised to spend no more than 30 minutes answering questions (a) - (f).

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- (a) What appeal has Lysias just made to Damnippus and what reasons does he give for his request?
 (b) ἔμπειρος . . . εἴη (lines 1–2). How did Lysias know that escape might be possible?
 (c) ἐδόκει . . . ἀποθανεῖσθαι (lines 2–5). State exactly what considerations went through Lysias'
- mind as he debated whether he should try to escape. [8]
- (d) Translate lines 5–9 $(\tau a \hat{v} \tau a \dots \hat{a} \delta \epsilon \lambda \varphi o \hat{v})$.

 Please write your translation on alternate lines. [15]
- (e) $\eta \kappa \omega \nu \dots M \dot{\epsilon} \gamma \alpha \rho \dot{\alpha} \delta \epsilon$ (lines 9–11).
 - (i) What information did Lysias receive about the fate of his brother? [2]
 - (ii) What was Lysias' reaction to the news? [2]

- (a) How has the corpse of Sarpedon just been treated?
- (b) $\Pi \acute{a} \tau \rho o \kappa \lambda o_S \ldots \kappa \acute{a} \lambda \epsilon \sigma \sigma a \nu$ (lines 1–10): what does Homer say about the reasons for Patroclus' death, and how is this forcefully expressed? You should refer to **both** the content **and** the style of the Greek and support your discussion with **four** examples from the Greek text. [8]

- (c) In lines 15–23 ($\tilde{\epsilon}\nu\theta\alpha$ $\kappa\epsilon\nu$. . . $\pi\rho\sigma\sigma\eta\dot{\nu}\delta\alpha$), in what ways is this passage especially dramatic? Give **five** examples, making reference to the Greek. [10]
- (d) $\chi \acute{a} \zeta \epsilon o \ldots \mathring{a} \mu \epsilon \acute{i} \nu \omega \nu$ (lines 24–26): how is the message to Patroclus given an air of authority? You should refer to **both** the content **and** the style of the Greek and support your discussion with **two** examples from the Greek text. [4]
