1 Planning Session (One hour and a quarter)

- (a) You are provided with the pattern of a nightdress Butterick 3312, View C with lace trim, collar and elasticated sleeves. You may choose to have long or short sleeves. You may also choose to lengthen the nightdress.
- (b) Make up the nightdress in a fabric of your choice. Using the carbonised sheets to make a duplicate copy, write out a shopping list of the requirements for completing the nightdress, giving an alternative for fabric, width and colours.
- (c) State four reasons for your first choice of fabric.
- (d) Please state your pattern size on the shopping list. The pattern should be divided for use in the Preparation Session.
- (e) Hand in the carbon copy of the shopping list, the pattern and the question paper to the Supervisor.

2 Preparation Session (Two hours)

- (a) Adjust the pattern in any way necessary to achieve a good fit.
- (b) Plan the layout of the nightdress and cut out the pieces you require, including the interfacing.
- (c) Mark the necessary fitting lines and balance points.
- (d) Assemble the nightdress for a fitting without the sleeves or collar.
- (e) Any remaining time may be used to prepare the collar.

Note You are to complete the preparation of the collar (tacking/basting only) after the Preparation Session in readiness for use in the Examination Session. [8]

Make up the nightdress to show:

- (a) The attachment of the lace trim and completion of the self facings;
- (b) (i) The attaching of the upper front to the skirtfront 7.
 - (ii) The completion of 60 cms of one side front seam 4.
 - (iii) The completion of the shoulder seams 4;
