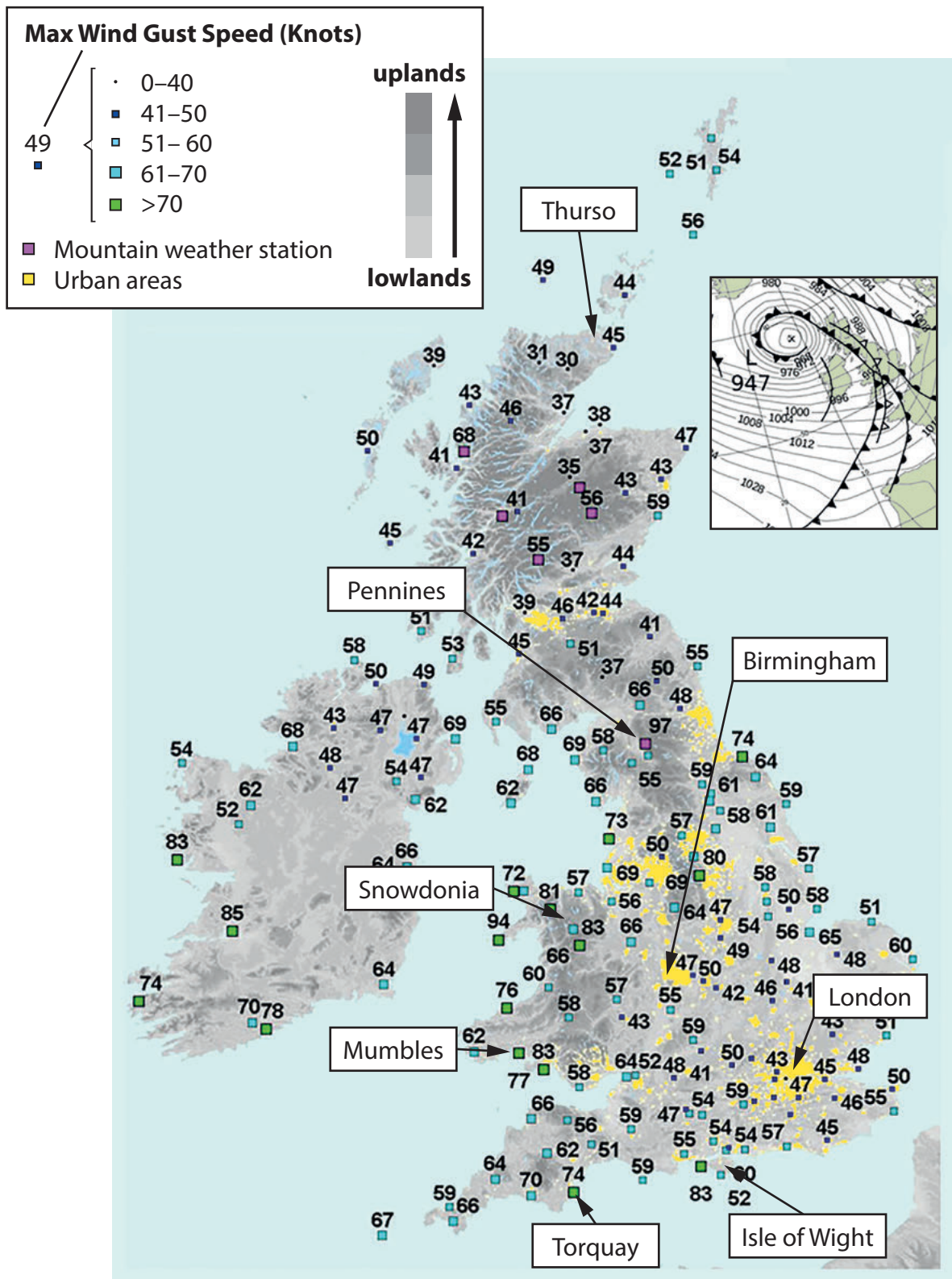

A synoptic chart and wind speeds recorded during the passage of a winter mid-latitude depression, 12–13 February 2014

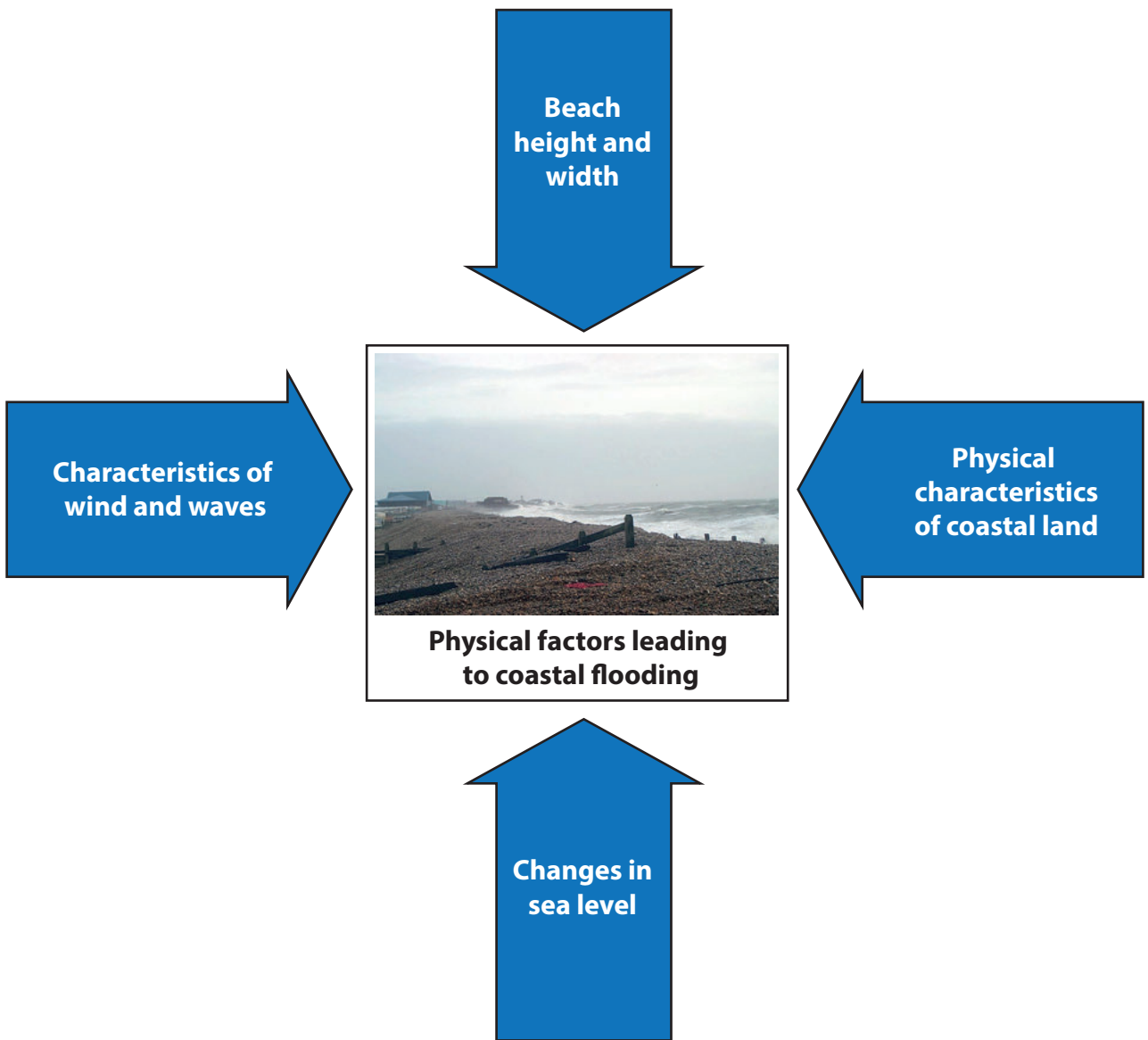
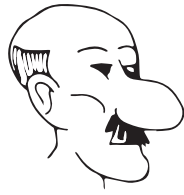

"Even with two of us working, our rent is so high that we can't save enough to buy our own house. It's just not affordable."



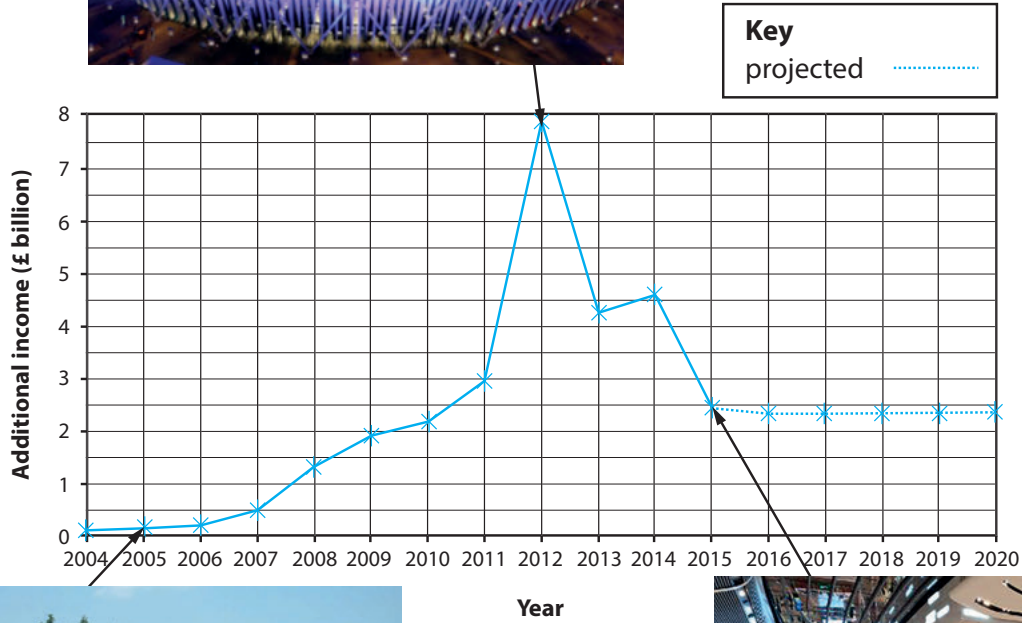
