GG4a. Landforms: Process and Management

1. Describe and assess the rôle of depositional processes in the production of distinctive landforms within your chosen geomorphic environment. [20]
2. Evaluate the success of management strategies in dealing with the impact of human activity on the natural environment in your chosen geomorphic environment. [20]

GG4b. Climatic Hazards: Causes and Management

3. With reference to your chosen climatic region, explain the formation of high pressure systems and describe the distinctive weather patterns they bring. [20]
4. Assess the short-term and long-term effects of the hazards associated with low pressure systems in your chosen climatic region. [20]

GG4c. Inequalities in Development

5. Examine the global inequalities that can be identified on the basis of the range of indicators used to measure world development. [20]
6. Identify and explain the factors responsible for recent changes in the relationship between the core and **one** peripheral area of a region you have studied. [20]

GG4d. Changing Geographies of Economic Activities

7. Assess the impacts of the globalisation of economic activity on LEDCs. [20]
8. Assess the strategies designed by different organisations and individuals for the sustainable management of economic activity in one region you have studied outside the UK. [20]
