## THE TOWER OF LONDON



Enjoy a wonderful day out at the *Tower of London\**, one of the world's major tourist attractions. Over two million visitors a year from all over the world come to admire this magnificent building.

William the Conqueror needed to show Londoners his authority, and by 1080 work had begun on building the massive *White Tower\**, over 27 metres high, at the centre of his London fortress. Later kings, including Henry VIII, modernised and added buildings.

From 1530 onwards, Henry's conflict with the Catholic Church increased the number of religious and political prisoners in the *Tower*. Anne Boleyn was executed here in 1536.

Attractions include:

- the world-famous Crown Jewels (nearly stolen in 1671!), priceless symbols of British monarchy
- the "*Beefeaters*" standing guard and giving tours.

## BRONTË PARSONAGE MUSEUM HAWORTH, WEST YORKSHIRE



The Brontës were an extraordinary literary family. The Reverend Patrick Brontë, his wife and their six children lived at the parsonage in Haworth. The two eldest daughters died in childhood, but the others survived to adulthood.

Charlotte's *Jane Eyre*\* and Emily's *Wuthering Heights*\* were both published in 1847 and are ranked among the greatest novels in the English language. But the father, daughter Anne and son Branwell all had works published too. The Brontës were a close family and the dramatic landscape of the surrounding moors provided them with inspiration for their writing.

The parsonage, a museum since 1928, was one of the largest houses in Haworth at the time and their home from 1820 to 1861. Twelve rooms have been restored to their original appearance with furniture, manuscripts and personal items.


## TREKKING IN LADAKH
