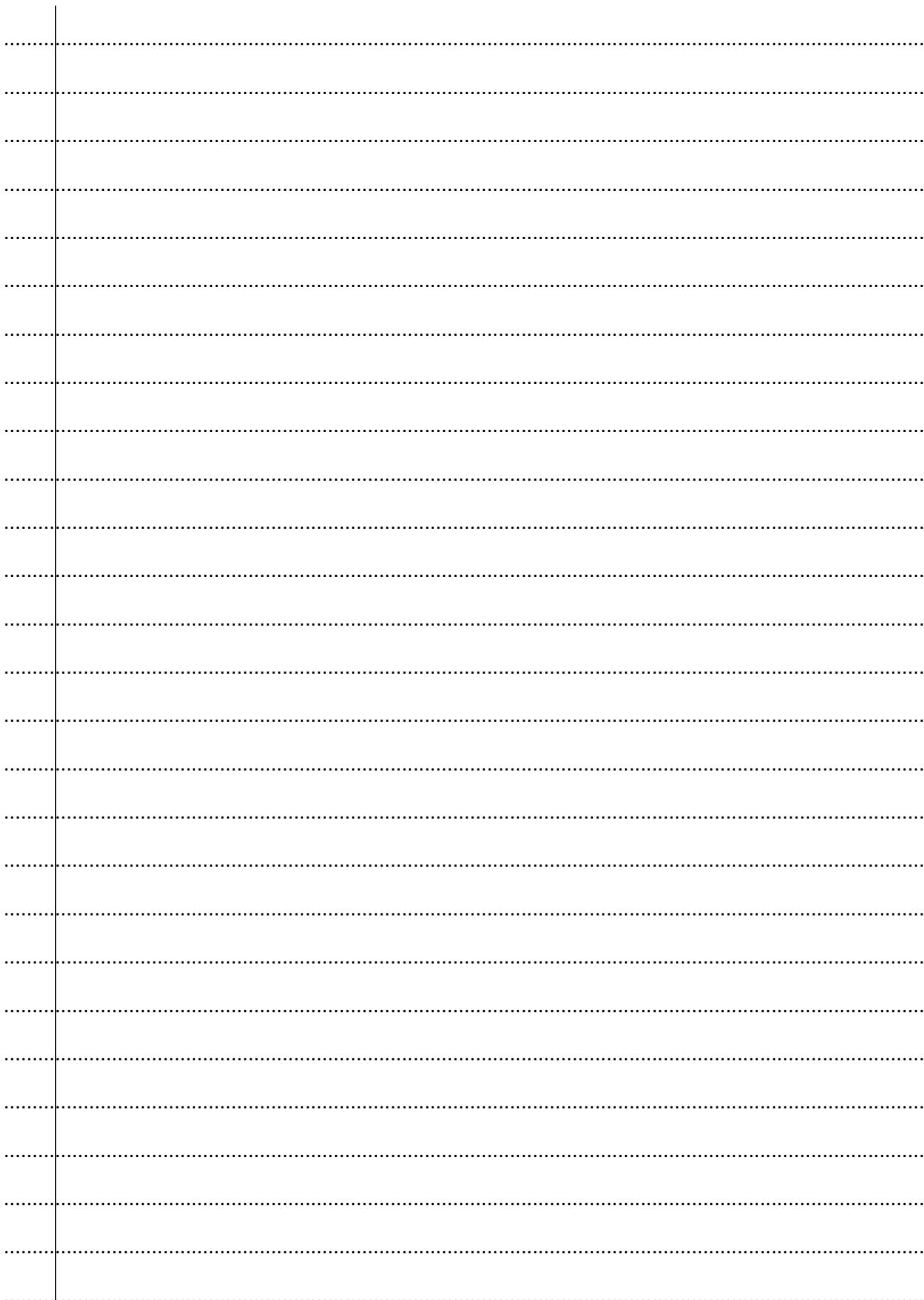
In answering each question, you are expected to cover relevant political ideas and concepts and, where appropriate, make reference to the views of political thinkers.

- 5 Discuss whether deterrence is the most important model of punishment used to shape party policies on crime in the UK. [50]
- 6 Discuss the significance of nationalist parties in the UK. [50]
- 7 Compare and contrast contemporary socialist and liberal attitudes towards welfare issues. [50]
- 8 “Gender imbalance is irrelevant in modern UK politics.” Discuss. [50]
