#### Unit 3 Option A: Revolution and Conflict in England

The lists of books and resources included below cannot be exhaustive given the range of scholarship available. Rather they attempt to select a range of publications that exemplify different levels, arguments and approaches to the study of this period. In some cases older works have been included in order to inform study of more recent interpretations and to enable students to gain some understanding of issues and debates related to the period. Candidates should understand that revisions and re-interpretations do not entirely replace earlier scholarship, but amend and offer a different emphasis and balance. It is also the case that some more general histories relate to both periods within this option, but are not included twice to avoid repetition. In particular, the Oxford Illustrated History of Tudor and Stuart Britain, edited by John Morrill and published by OUP in 1996 covers the whole period and offers a useful bibliographical list as well as a range of articles and contributions.
