- (a) Explain why Henry VII needed to improve the Crown's finances. [24]

2. Religious changes in Wales and England, c. 1500-1559.

- (a) Explain why Protestants were persecuted during the reign of Mary. [24]
- (b) To what extent was Parliament mainly responsible for religious change in Wales and England in the period 1500-1559? [36]

3. Tudor Rebellions, c. 1536-1554.

- (a) Explain why Wyatt's rebellion broke out. [24]
- (b) To what extent was economic depression mainly responsible for causing the Tudor rebellions in the period 1536-1554? [36]
