2. Martin Luther and the German Reformation, 1517-1555.

- (a) Explain why Luther challenged the Catholic Church in Germany. [24]
- (b) To what extent was the development of the German Reformation mainly due to the support of the peasants? [36]

3. The growth and spread of Protestantism in the sixteenth century.

- (a) Explain why Zwingli and Luther's relationship was strained. [24]
- (b) To what extent was the development of Calvinism the most important factor in the growth and spread of Protestantism in the sixteenth century? [36]
