2. Religious Reformation and change, c.1529-1570

- (a) Explain why the Elizabethan Church Settlement was introduced. [24]
- (b) To what extent was the Henrician Reformation the most significant factor in promoting religious change in the period 1529-1570? [36]

3. Protest, Disorder and Rebellion, c.1529-1569

- (a) Explain why the Wyatt rebellion broke out. [24]
- (b) To what extent was the Crown mainly responsible for the failure of the rebellions in the period 1529-1569? [36]
