1. International relations, c. 1878-1920

- (a) Explain why there was rivalry between Austria-Hungary and Serbia between 1878-1914. [24]

2. Italy, c. 1918-1944

- (a) Explain why the Matteotti crisis of 1924 was important for Mussolini. [24]
- (b) To what extent was government propaganda mainly responsible for maintaining the support of the Italian people between 1922-1944? [36]

3. The Communist revolution in Russia, c. 1917-1941

- (a) Explain why Lenin stayed in power after 1917. [24]
- (b) To what extent did economic policy have the most significant impact upon Russian society in the period 1917-1941? [36]
