Your finished advertisement will fit on a single sheet of paper and look like this:



- 1 Using a suitable software package, start a new drawing. Draw a large rectangle.

- 2 Insert a picture of some flowers from clipart, scanner or digital camera and place it in the top left corner of the rectangle.

- 3 Reduce the size of the image by about half. Do not distort the image. 2.2.1 ✓
- 4 Make a copy of this image and place it in the bottom right corner of the rectangle. 2.1.1



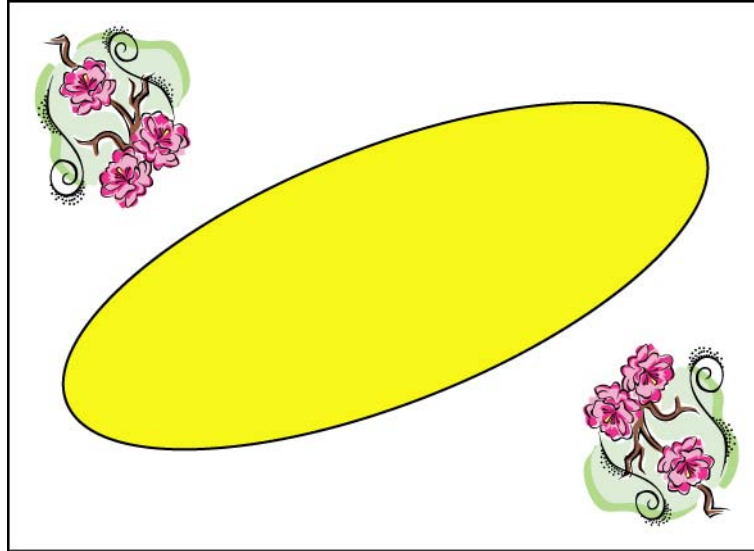
- 5 Rotate the new image by 180 degrees. 2.4.1



- 6 Draw an oval shape. Colour this shape yellow.
Rotate it and place it across the middle of the rectangle as shown below.

- 7 Add the text **Flowers for mother's day** in large letters (18 to 36 point) and a dark colour.

Rotate this text and place it in the yellow oval.



- 8 Add your name and today's date to the bottom of the page. Save your drawing using a new filename and print it. [✓] 3.1.1
- 9 Reduce the size of the whole image by about half and make a second print of it. 2.5.1
