2. Critically consider the criminal law when dealing with misleading price indications in respect of consumer products and services. [25]
  
3. “The doctrine of freedom of contract is completely irrelevant in the modern consumer age.” Discuss. [25]
  
4. “An advertisement is always an invitation to treat and can never be an offer.” Discuss. [25]
  
5. Critically evaluate the recent reforms of consumer credit law. [25]
  
6. To what extent, if at all, does the implementation of the Unfair Commercial Practices Directive outlaw unfair practice by traders in consumer transactions? [25]
