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**The Event/Skill/Position column should be completed for activities where either different events or skills are assessed.** Centres will need to identify the events/skills in line with the requirements of the assessment criteria for the activity. For team game activities please indicate position where appropriate.

In activities where candidates are assessed both subjectively in terms of technique using the assessment criteria and objectively using the published OCR performance tables, for example in athletics or swimming, the different elements should each be assessed out of 40, and then an average mark calculated to reach an overall final assessment out of 40 for the activity as a whole. The same is true where more than one event or skill area is required, as in cricket where batting or bowling, plus fielding, must be assessed.

**Example 1: activity with performance tables**

(In example 1, swimming, because the activity has performance tables the effective performance mark should be arrived at by awarding a mark for technique out of 40 using the assessment criteria for the activity area and the specific activity, and a mark for effective performance out of 40 based upon outcomes measured against the published OCR performance tables for that activity. The average of these two marks is then used as the overall mark out of 40 for the activity.)

<b>Activity</b>	Swimming

Technique assessment mark in the 'Event' column (25/40) + performance assessment mark (35/40) = 60

The total mark for swimming is then calculated as 60 / 2 = 30 overall.

**Example 2: team game**

(In example 2, where the assessment of the activity cannot be objectively measured using performance tables, one mark based on assessment against the OCR criteria for that activity is all that is required.)

As only one overall mark is required, this can be given in the 'Event' column with information provided about the position played and confirmed in the 'overall mark' column.

**Example 3: an activity with different specific skill areas to be assessed:-**

(The activity criteria require candidates to be assessed in more than one skill area, in this case in cricket, one of batting or bowling, plus fielding)

<b>Activity</b>	Cricket

0077	T. Stevens	M	Bowling	38	Fielding	16	-	26

Bowling mark (38/40) + Fielding mark (16/40) = 54; 54 / 2 = overall mark of 26.
