4. Describe and evaluate the benefits of relationships on psychological well-being. [25]
5. Analyse and evaluate issues relating to the measurement of intelligence. [25]

7. Describe and evaluate explanations for the nature of dreams. [25]

9. Discuss the effect of individual differences in learning styles. [25]
10. Comment on the treatment and punishment of crime with reference to psychological theories and research findings. [25]
