Question 1 Kant and ethics

0 | 2 'Kant's theory of ethics is completely compatible with a religious approach to ethics.'

Assess this claim. (15 marks)

Question 2 Natural Law and ethics

0 | 3 Explain Finnis' Natural Law theory. (30 marks)

and

0 | 4 Assess the view that Finnis' Natural Law theory has more strengths than weaknesses. (15 marks)

Question 3 Religious views of the created world

0 | 5 Explain what is meant by saying that the world was created according to God's intentions. (30 marks)

and

0 | 6 'Any world created by God must be perfect.'

Discuss how far this is true. (15 marks)

Question 4 Environment, both local and worldwide

0 | 7 Explain the ethical reasons behind attempts to restrict Third World development. (30 marks)

and

0 | 8 'Protection of the environment should be an issue only for the rich.'

Assess this claim. (15 marks)
