Assess this claim. *(15 marks)*

Question 2 Expressions of religion within society

0 | 3 Examine the various forms of places of worship found in the United Kingdom (UK) today. *(30 marks)*

and

0 | 4 'An essential aspect of a place of worship is that it is "set apart" and different from other buildings around it.'
How far do you agree? *(15 marks)*

Question 3 Issues of identity and belonging

0 | 5 Examine the ways in which **one or more** religion(s) attempt to maintain a sense of community. *(30 marks)*

and

0 | 6 'It is extremely hard to maintain a sense of community when a religion is in a minority within the wider society.'
Assess this claim. *(15 marks)*

Question 4 An introduction to New Religious Movements (NRMs)

0 | 7 Examine some sociological reasons which have been suggested for the rise of New Religious Movements. *(30 marks)*

and

0 | 8 'New Religious Movements have no relevance in the 21st century.'
Assess this claim. *(15 marks)*
