**Question 3 Psychology and religion**

- 0 5** Examine ways in which Freud challenged belief in God. *(30 marks)*

and

- 0 6** 'Religious faith is necessary for good mental health.'
- How far do you agree? *(15 marks)*

**Question 4 Atheism and postmodernism**

- 0 7** Explain what is meant by:
- 'There is no God'
  - 'God is dead'.
- (30 marks)*

and

- 0 8** 'Religion has not responded successfully to the challenge of atheism.'
- To what extent do you agree? *(15 marks)*
