- 2 (a) Describe the nature and course of the persecutions which took place during the reigns of the Emperors Domitian and Marcus Aurelius. [35 marks]

(b) Comment on the claim that there was no consistent policy of persecution in the Roman Empire. Justify your answer. [15 marks]

- 3 (a)** Explain the reasons why the Bishop became the most important figure in the life of the Church during the first three centuries. [35 marks]
- (b)** With reference to other aspects of human experience, explore the claim that Church leaders should always be trusted to make wise decisions. Justify your answer. [15 marks]
- 4 (a)** Describe the main features of the writings of the Apologists, with reference to Justin Martyr. [35 marks]
- (b)** With reference to other aspects of human experience, comment on the view that writers will always be needed to explain and defend religious faith in a secular age. Justify your answer. [15 marks]
