(b) 'There is evidence in Mark's story of the Passion that Jesus could have avoided his death.' Discuss. [10]
- 4 (a) Describe and explain the significant features of the resurrection of Jesus in Matthew's Gospel. [25]  
(b) 'Matthew's account of the resurrection of Jesus is unconvincing.' Discuss. [10]
