Accessing health services while in England

As a citizen from the EU, you should bring a valid card (EHIC) to show you have health insurance from your own country. If you need treatment, confirm that you do not have to pay for this, for example by showing proof of identity.



In an emergency, call 999 or 112 for an ambulance and give details.

Everyone is entitled to immediate care and attention.



If you need to see a doctor

- o register as a temporary patient if you are in the area for less than three months.
- o visit a walk-in centre in some towns – most are open 365 days a year and outside office hours. You do not need an appointment.

Remember

Each country's system may be different – your card might not cover everything that is free in your country.



You pay the same for prescriptions as UK residents.

There are charges for dental treatment and other services, e.g. opticians.
