

**Assessment Evidence**

Assessment evidence will typically consist of:

- the presentation of a portfolio of work – this includes the organization of the work in the portfolio, the selection and use of suitable methods for formal and informal presentation of work, and making presentations
- investigating progression routes – this includes identifying aims, investigating routes and requirements, preparation of personal information, and taking part in mock interviews.

Your work must include evidence of:

- a personal presentation and communication skills
- b portfolio presentation techniques
- c identifying and pursuing progression goals
