- 2. Read the tasks carefully to make sure that you understand what is needed.
- 3. Carry out all tasks and make sure that you check your work carefully to ensure that the work you produce is accurate and correct.
- 4. You have a total of two hours to complete your work. *The Recommendation* is worth 20 marks and *The Implementation* is worth 40 marks. You are advised to divide your time accordingly.
- 5. You will be using *Network Design Software* for *The Recommendation*.
- 6. You will be using *Server Simulation Software* for *The Implementation*.

The Recommendation

Instructions for candidates

In the folder named *Network Design Software* there is an internet shortcut icon named *Network Design*. Double click the icon to run the Network Design Software.

You will see a plan of Gwesty'r Pentref with the existing hardware and eleven physical network components to be used to design the network.

A component is selected by clicking the component once. It will appear on the plan. It can then be dragged to the required location on the plan of Gwesty'r Pentref and dropped.

You can use any of the network components as many times as required.

If you want to remove a component it can be dragged and dropped into the bin located to the right of the plan.

The components can be dropped anywhere in a location but it must be clear in which location each component is placed.

You are required to provide a screen shot and a written response for Task 1 and written responses for Task 2, Task 3 and Task 4 all to be saved in a document named *The Recommendation*.

Save your work regularly.

The new system

The hotel reception staff and hotel manager will make room reservations. When a guest checks out of the hotel their bill will be printed at the Hotel Reception.

Guests and visitors will need to contact reception to book a table at the Restaurant, a beauty treatment at the Health Club and a fitness session at the Fitness Centre.

The Restaurant manager and their team at the Restaurant will be able to check the booking when a guest or visitor arrives to eat at the Restaurant.

The Health Club manager and their team at the Health Club will be able to check the booking when a guest or visitor arrives for a treatment at the Health Club.

The Fitness Centre manager and their team at the Fitness Centre will be able to check the booking when a guest or visitor arrives for a session at the Fitness Centre.

Hotel guests will receive a discount at the Restaurant, Health Club and Fitness Centre.

The hotel manager would like to be able to contact all previous visitors and guests to promote the hotel and facilities. This could be achieved by sending a letter to inform guests of special offers when the hotel has low occupancy.

The manager would also like management information about the performance of each section of the business.

Gwesty'r Pentref is going to employ new permanent staff and many temporary staff to work in the new facilities.

The Objectives

These objectives should be read carefully and referred to throughout Part B.

The Objectives for the new system are to allow:

- 1. the network to be managed from the Hotel Reception
- 2. the manager in the Restaurant to update the Booking Database and view the Room Reservation Database
- 3. the manager in the Health Club to update the Booking Database and view the Room Reservation Database
- 4. the manager in the Fitness Centre to update the Booking Database and view the Room Reservation Database
- 5. the staff in the Restaurant to view the Booking and Room Reservation Databases
- 6. the staff in the Health Club to view the Booking and Room Reservation Databases
- 7. the staff in the Fitness Centre to view the Booking and Room Reservation Databases
- 8. the hotel manager and the hotel reception staff to update the Booking and Room Reservation Databases
- 9. the hotel manager and the hotel reception staff to save created database reports for the Booking and Room Reservation Databases
- 10. the hotel manager and the hotel reception staff to print out room bills at the Hotel Reception.

Open a new word processed document and save it as *The Recommendation*.

Using the *Network Design Software*, select the **most appropriate** physical network components and position these in the **most suitable location** to design a network that will allow the staff at Gwesty'r Pentref to achieve *The Objectives*.

When you have completed your network design take a screen shot of the plan of Gwesty'r Pentref and save it in *The Recommendation* document.

Close the Network Design Software.

Justify your choice of each physical network component that you used to design the network, clearly stating the reason for the location of each physical network component.

Gwesty'r Pentref could use a wireless communication infrastructure or cable communication infrastructure to connect the physical network components. Give detailed reasons why Gwesty'r Pentref has decided to use a wireless communication infrastructure to connect the physical network components that you selected in Task 1.

You are required to provide written responses and screen shots for the tasks all to be saved in a document named *The Implementation*.

Rules used when naming objects in network systems ensure the objects will be recognised by different systems and older versions of existing systems. These rules are used when the network is initially installed and also later when adding new objects such as computers.
