Information for OCR centres transferring to **new specifications for first teaching in September 2008**



Candidates may still respond to narrative questions within the examination with an emphasis on their chosen A2 option specialism. | • Unit title changing to Strategic management. More numerate content has been added including the content previously found within units 2871, 2872, 2873 (as detailed above).
