

- 0 3 How successfully has the architect solved the problems of constructing this type of tomb? (10 marks)
- How important are the structural remains at Mycenae, other than those of graves, to our understanding of Mycenaean society? Evaluate the advantages and limitations of this kind of evidence. (20 marks)
