Information for OCR centres transferring to the **new specifications for first** teaching in 2008

It is intended to help ease the transition for Heads of Department and Teachers involved in the teaching of Classical Greek.

- All coursework to be removed from Classical Greek
- Stretch and Challenge style questions to be introduced into A2 assessment
