Subject: GCE Classics: Latin and Classical Greek

Changes to structure of question papers – for first examination June 2013

From the June 2013 series onwards, the GCE AS Latin (F361 and F362) and Classical Greek (F371 and F372) and A2 Latin (F363 and F364) and Classical Greek (F373 and F374) papers will no longer be presented in the form of a separate question paper and answer booklet. These will be combined and there will be spaces provided in the question paper where the candidates will write their answers. New specimen papers will be available on the website to illustrate the new format.

As part of this change to the format of the papers, the order of Section A and Section B is being reversed in A2 Latin (F363 and F364) and A2 Classical Greek (F373 and F374). Section A will now contain the unprepared translation and comprehension questions and Section B will contain the questions on the set texts.

- Latin A2 F363 Section A: unprepared translation and comprehension; Section B: set texts
- Classical Greek A2 F373: Section A: unprepared translation and comprehension; Section B: set texts
- Latin A2 F364 Section A: unprepared translation and comprehension or prose composition; Section B: set texts
- Classical Greek A2 F374: Section A: unprepared translation and comprehension or prose composition;
 Section B: set texts
