

Choreograph and perform a dance based on the popular music, fashion trends and social dance styles of the chosen decade.

In your Programme Note, you should identify the decade and trends that you have chosen, in sufficient detail to inform the examiner.

2 Choreograph and perform a dance based on *Der Mensch im Ideenkreis (Man in the Circle of Ideas)* (1928) by Oskar Schlemmer, illustrated below, **and** the supporting text.
