- 2.2 It is not mandatory to use a computer. However, if a centre intends for its candidates to use a computer for the presentation of some or all of the tasks in the 6934 candidate brief during the controlled assessment, a desktop computer must be made available for each candidate to use on an individual basis.
- 2.8 If portable electronic storage media (e.g. floppy discs, CDRs, flash/pen drives) are used by candidates to save their work these portable storage media MUST be provided by the centre. If portable storage media are used the invigilator should hand them out at the beginning of each session of the controlled assessment and collect them in at the end of each session.
- 2.12 If candidates are NOT completing work using a computer their handwritten work must be collected in at the end of each controlled assessment session.
