CHANGE OF EXAMINATION PAPER FORMAT FROM JANUARY 2013 ALL OCR ENGLISH QUESTION PAPERS

The examination papers for all English examined units will be changing from the January 2013 series. Candidates will be provided with answer booklets that are specific to each unit, rather than generic answer booklets. It is important that the relevant answer booklet is used for each exam. Generic answer booklets from previous exam series should be destroyed.

The new format of each question paper is detailed below.

The question number(s) must be clearly shown if this space is used. The reading source material for Section A will still be provided on a separate insert (the Reading Booklet), so that candidates may refer to it as they write their answers to Section A.

Teachers may like to show these versions to candidates or use them for mock examinations in order to familiarise candidates with the new format.
