Section A: Language and Speech

This section is compulsory.

Candidates answer the question to demonstrate knowledge and understanding of the key constituents of language. Passages will be drawn from relevant books and articles and may include transcribed data.

EITHER

Section B: The Language of Popular Written Texts (page 20)

Candidates answer one question to demonstrate knowledge and understanding of linguistic variants in written texts...

OR

Section C: Language and Cultural Production (page 20)

Candidates answer one question to demonstrate knowledge and understanding of linguistic variants of the cultural industries...

OR

Section D: Language, Power and Identity (page 21)

Candidates answer one question to demonstrate knowledge and understanding of how the linguistic constituents of these areas construct and challenge varieties of power and identity...
