ALTERNATIVE MEDICINE

1 A tabloid newspaper is beginning a series on non-conventional medicines, which will give information and guidance on the most popular of these.

Use the material provided to write the opening article of the series outlining the history, theory and practical applications of alternative medicine. You should include in your article some comments on the different views about these areas of medicine.

Write about 1000 words.

Give a brief indication of your preferred layout and include any illustrative material that you wish to be used.

Your text should be accompanied by a commentary in which you explain some of the significant decisions and choices you have made in writing it. The commentary should be approximately 150 - 200 words.

2 A group of practitioners is opening a centre for the practice of Homeopathy, Reflexology and Acupuncture.

Use the material provided to write a leaflet that will inform, guide and reassure prospective patients about the methods of treatment. You should include in your leaflet comments on some of the ideas that lie behind alternative medicine.

Write about 1000 words.

Give a brief indication of your preferred layout and include any illustrative material that you wish to be used.

Your text should be accompanied by a commentary in which you explain some of the significant decisions and choices you have made in writing it. The commentary should be approximately 150 - 200 words.

4 A local Leisure Centre is expanding into extreme sports. To promote this new fitness initiative they have commissioned a series of web pages to be published on their site. These pages, designed for a family audience, will show the attractions of the sports with special emphasis on how they can promote a healthy lifestyle.

Use the material provided to write the pages Mountain Biking: Your Fun Ride to Fitness.

Write about 1000 words.

Give a brief indication of your preferred design.

Your text should be accompanied by a commentary in which you explain some of the significant decisions and choices you have made in writing it. The commentary should be approximately 150 - 200 words.
