Answer **one** question from this section.

Each question carries 25 marks.

- 1** (a) In the context of vegetation studies, define **each** of the following terms:
- (i) succession
 - (ii) plagioclimax. *(4 marks)*
- (b) Describe and explain the processes involved in the succession known as a lithosere. *(6 marks)*
- (c) Discuss **two** ways in which vegetation successions within the British Isles may be modified by human activities. *(7 marks)*
- (d) Using **an annotated diagram**, describe and suggest reasons for the characteristic features of **either** a podzol **or** a brown earth. *(8 marks)*
- 2** (a) In the context of the theory of plate tectonics, define **each** of the following terms:
- (i) destructive plate margin
 - (ii) constructive plate margin. *(4 marks)*
- (b) Using **an annotated diagram**, outline the effects of tectonic processes at **either** a destructive plate margin **or** a constructive plate margin. *(8 marks)*
- (c) Describe the processes that operate at 'hot spots', located away from plate boundaries. *(6 marks)*
- (d) Discuss how **two** pieces of evidence support the theory of plate tectonics. *(7 marks)*

SECTION B

Answer **one** question from this section.

Each question carries 25 marks.

3 *'The ability to manage hazards depends on where they occur.'*

Discuss this statement with reference to **one** major urban area where multiple hazards occur.

In your answer, you should:

- identify the hazards that affect the urban area, giving their origin, frequency and scale
- describe the effects that the hazards have on the area, including any interrelationship(s) between them
- discuss the types of response to the hazards. (25 marks)

4 *'During the last 30 years, there has been a tendency for countries to group together. At the same time separatist pressures exist within countries.'*

Discuss this statement.

In your answer, you should:

- describe the growth of **one or more** groups of nations
- outline the reasons for the development of such groups
- give reasons for separatist pressures. (25 marks)
