Electricity generation by fuel type for the EU and selected countries (2003)

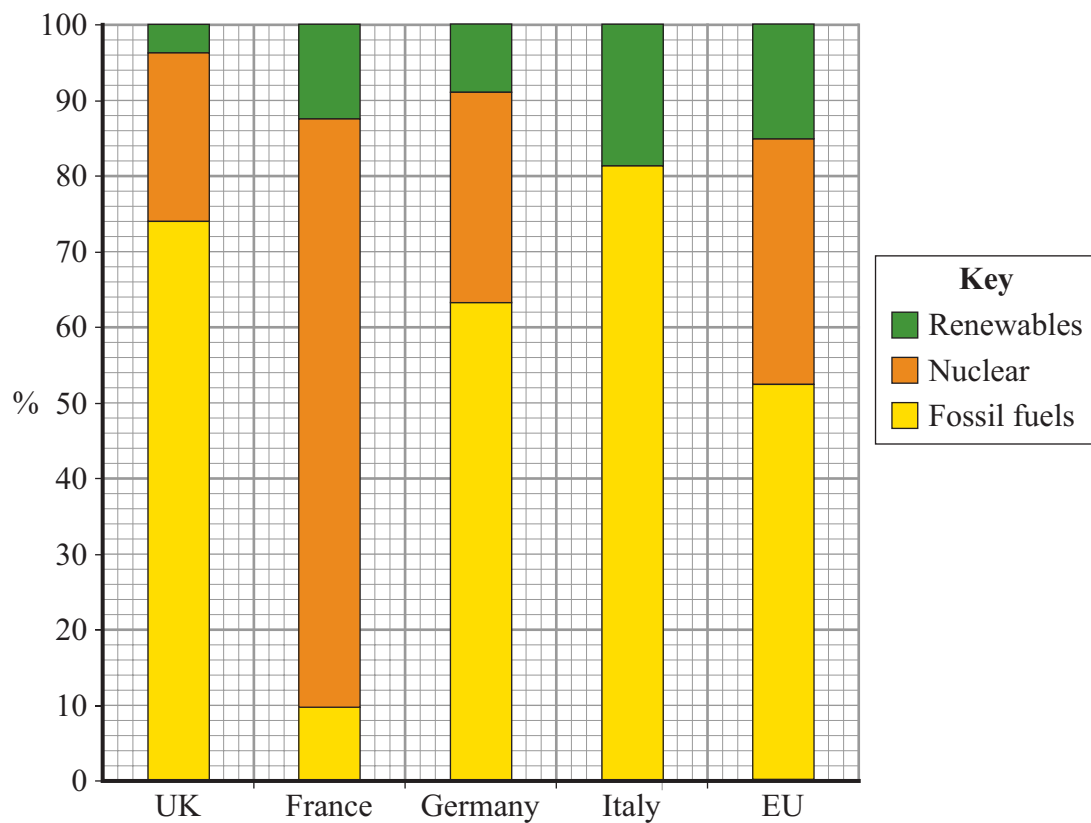
