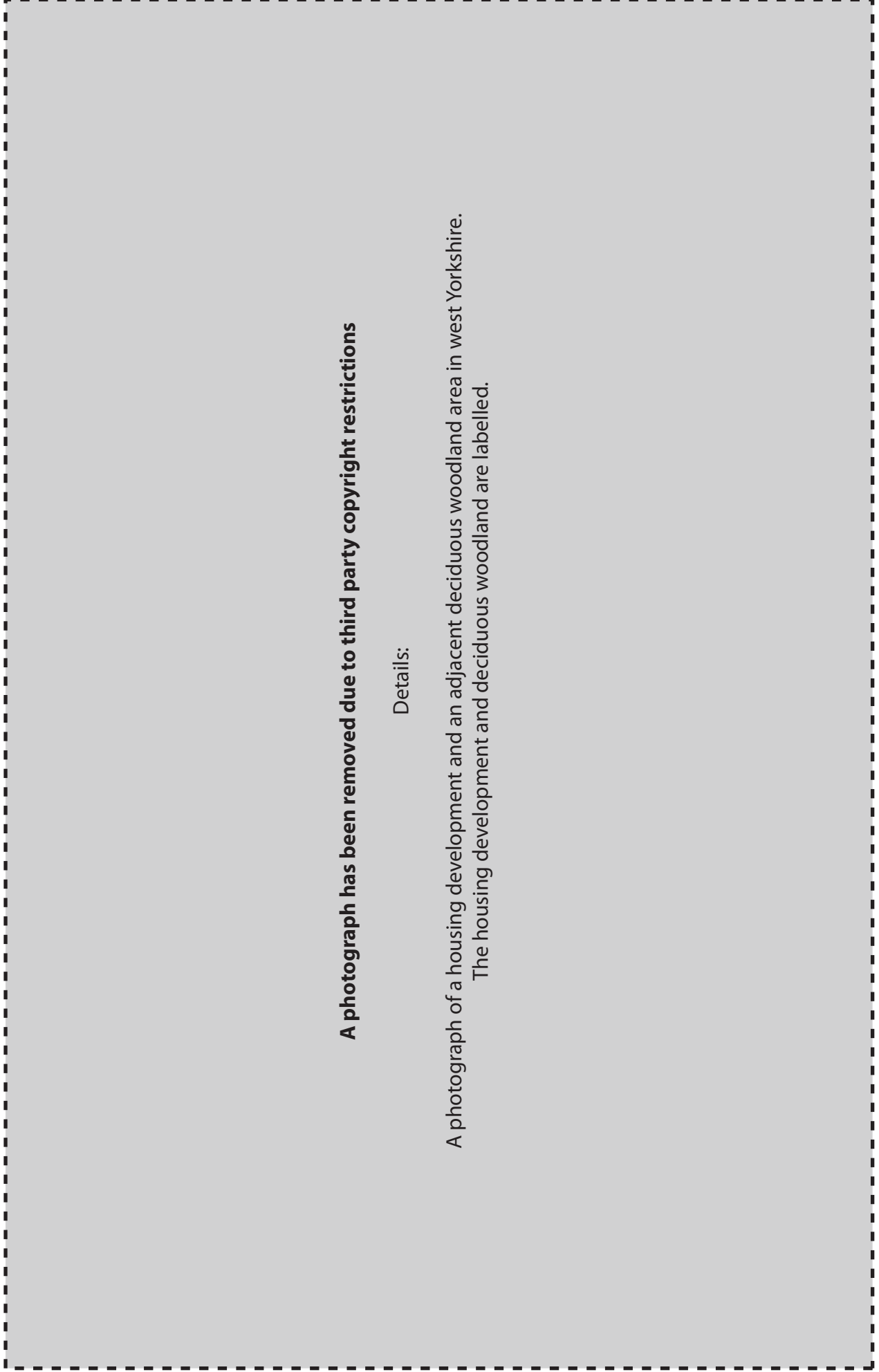


Fig. 2 The nutrient cycle of a deciduous woodland
