INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETION OF THE REPORT

- 1 The report may be hand-written or word-processed. It should be presented in continuous prose. Only essential illustrations should be included.
- 2 A4 paper should be used for the report. If larger sheets are desirable for illustrations these should be no larger than A3 folded to A4.
- 3 The sheets must not be enclosed in plastic pockets or put into any type of folder. They should instead be held together by means of a single hole (punched in the top left hand corner of the sheets) and a treasury tag.
- 4 The investigation should not exceed 1000 words. It should be presented in continuous prose divided into sections by the headings below.
 - Identification of the question
 - Development of a strategy
 - Collection of Data
 - Analysis, Evaluation and Interpretation
 - Presentation of a summary

Sub-headings within main headings are acceptable.

- 5 Since June 2003 OCR has recorded the marks for the Written Paper (component 01) and the Report (component 02) separately. The component 02 mark can then be carried forward in subsequent examination sessions.

N.B. Candidates entering 2682 for the first time (or wishing to re-sit both components 01 and 02) must be entered for Option A, the Written Paper and Report. Option B enables candidates to re-sit the Written Paper and carry forward their Report mark from a previous session.

- 6 Candidates may wish to keep a copy of their report to use for revision purposes should they decide to re-sit Unit 2682.
