

Fig. 3 A map of global energy consumption

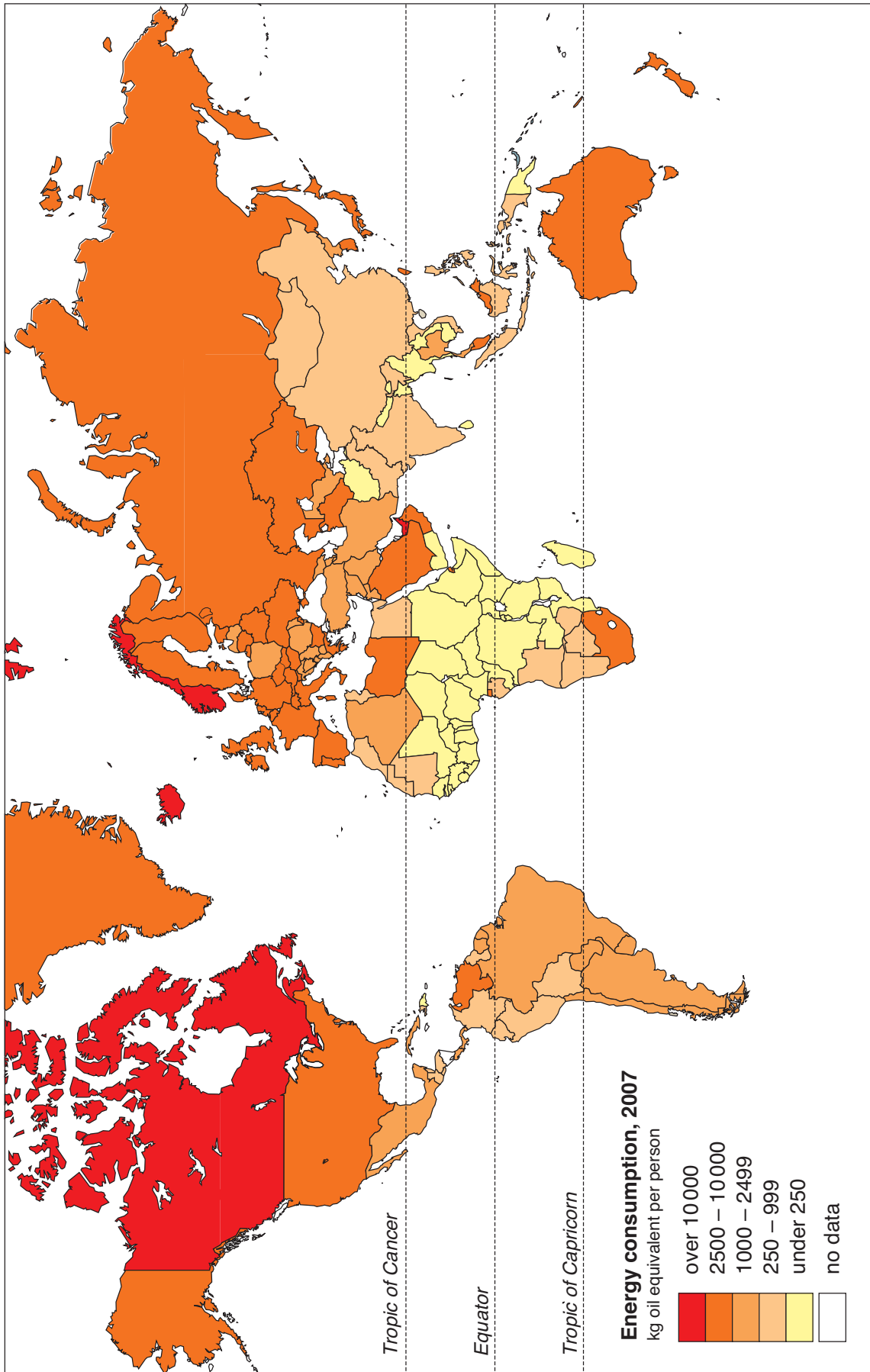
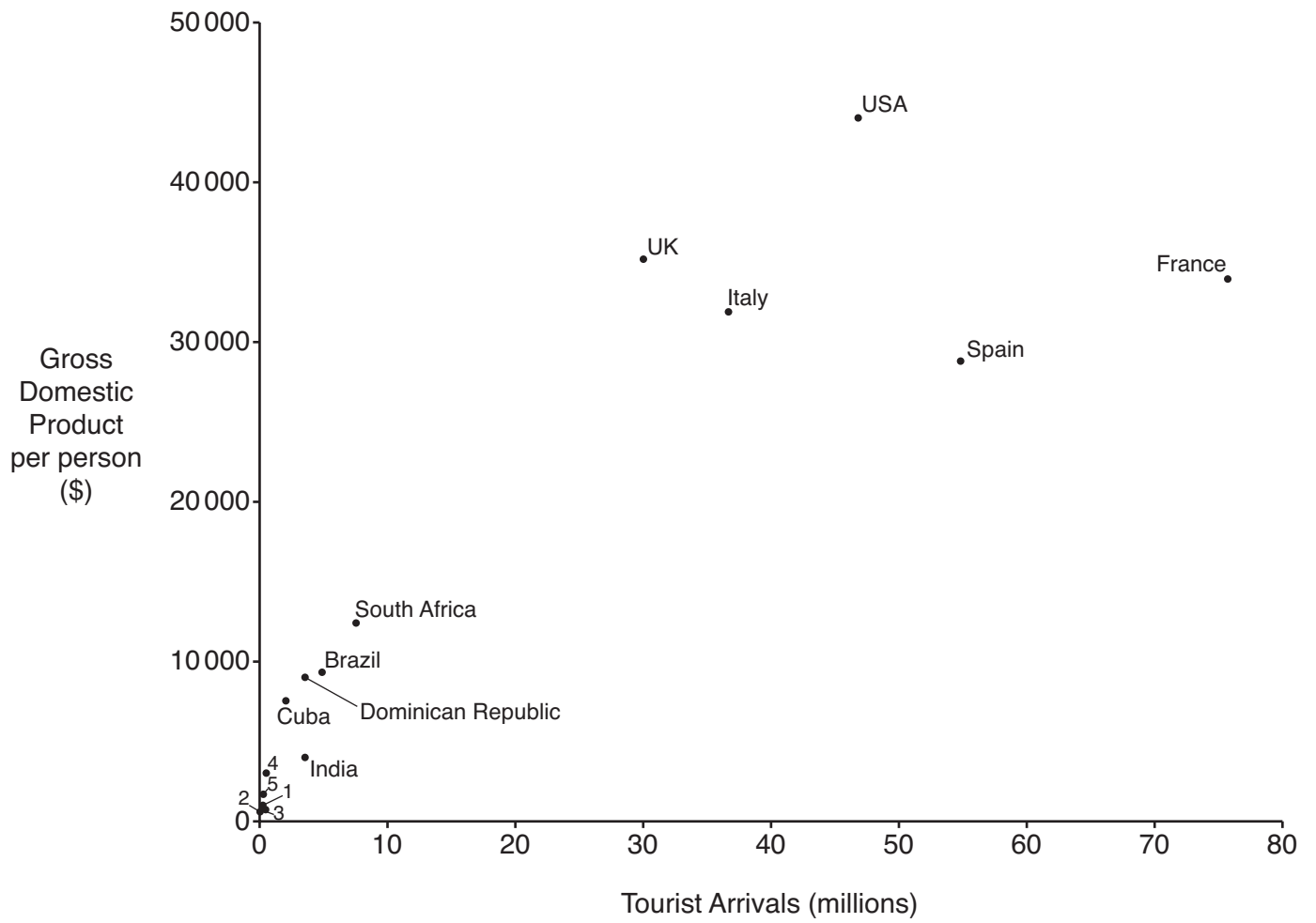


Fig. 4 Tourist arrivals and Economic Development (G.D.P. per person) (2006)
