- 1. Describe and explain the rôle of high energy events, compared with longer periods of stability, in the development of landforms in your chosen geomorphic environment. [20]
- 2. Explain why opinions differ over the success of strategies used to manage the impacts of human activity on the natural environment. [20]

GG4b. Climatic Hazards: Causes and Management

- **3.** Explain how high and low pressure systems create distinctive weather patterns in your chosen climatic region. [20]
- 4. Explain why there is a variation in the level of hazard and element of risk associated with low pressure systems in your chosen climatic region. [20]

- 5. Discuss the effectiveness of different quantitative **and** qualitative indicators used to measure global inequalities. [20]
- 6. Account for the development of a core of relative wealth and a periphery of relative poverty in one region outside the UK. [20]

- 7. Assess the impacts of the globalisation of economic activity on MEDCs. [20]
- 8. Explain recent changes in the nature of economic activity that have taken place within one region outside the UK and identify their social and environmental impacts. [20]
