(10 marks) 0 6 'Educational reforms in recent years have been driven by pragmatism rather than ideology.' Discuss. (30 marks) **Topic 4 The Economy** Explain why those on the left tend to prefer progressive rather than regressive taxation. (10 marks) 0 8 'There are no significant differences between the economic policies of the major British political parties.' Discuss. (30 marks)
