### 1. The Electoral Process and Direct Democracy

- (a) Explain why the system of primaries in US elections can be criticised. [10]
- (b) 'Recent elections have confirmed the media as the most significant factor affecting the outcome.' Discuss. [30]

### 2. Political Parties

- (a) Explain why factions exist in the Democratic Party. [10]
- (b) 'For the main political parties in the USA, the economy causes more disagreement than any other issue.' Discuss. [30]

## 3. Voting Behaviour

- (a) Explain the significance of religion as a factor influencing voting behaviour in the USA. [10]
- (b) Analyse whether short-term factors are now more important than core voting coalitions in determining voting behaviour in the USA. [30]

### 4. Pressure Groups

- (a) Explain why there are so many pressure groups in the USA. [10]
- (b) Assess whether corporate groups or issue groups have more influence in the American political system. [30]
