1. Globalisation

- (a) Explain how the political influence of multinational and transnational corporations can be defended. [10]
- (b) 'Small states have no role in a globalised world.' Discuss. [30]

2. Environmentalism

- (a) Explain how environmentalism opposes anthropocentrism. [10]
- (b) Critically assess the argument that environmentalism is more successful when operating outside conventional party politics. [30]

3. Feminism

- (a) Explain why the concept of patriarchy is important in feminism. [10]
- (b) 'It is now impossible to distinguish any common ideas and thinking between the different types of feminism.' Discuss. [30]

4. Multiculturalism

- (a) Explain why positive discrimination is important within multiculturalism. [10]
- (b) 'The promotion of language and culture has been more successful than other methods of promoting multiculturalism.' Discuss. [30]
