1. The Constitutional Framework of US Government

(a) Explain the significance of the US Constitution. [10]

(b) 'The US Constitution is too flexible.' Discuss. [30]

2. The Legislative Branch of Government: the US Congress

(a) Explain the importance of committees within Congress. [10]

(b) Assess whether parties have any importance for the relationship between Congress and the Executive. [30]

3. The Executive Branch of Government

- (a) Explain how the Constitution restricts the powers of the president. [10]
- (b) Evaluate the view that US presidents have more power in foreign affairs than in domestic affairs. [30]

4. The Judicial Branch of Government: the Supreme Court

- (a) Explain why Supreme Court landmark judgements have impact in the USA. [10]
- (b) Discuss the view that in reality the Supreme Court has less political significance than its critics claim it has. [30]
