Choose **TWO** of the questions that follow, and answer both parts, (a) and (b), for both the questions that you choose.

#### 1. Globalisation

- (a) Explain how globalisation affects Britain's evolving world position. [10]
- (b) Discuss whether the global influence and impact of corporations and NGOs are more positive than negative. [30]

## 2. Environmentalism

- (a) Explain why political parties, other than the Green Party, have not really embraced Green issues. [10]
- (b) 'The challenges of consumerism and capitalism are too great for Environmentalism to ever succeed.' Discuss. [30]

## 3. Feminism

- (a) Explain the impact of increasing female political representation. [10]
- (b) Evaluate whether public attitudes have now changed sufficiently for feminism to have no purpose. [30]

## 4. Multiculturalism

- (a) Explain why tackling institutional racism is important in multiculturalism. [10]
- (b) Assess whether the most effective way of achieving multiculturalism is through major legislation to protect minority rights. [30]
