Question 4

1 7 Allow 1 mark for each comparison point of males and females – e.g. females have more stress headaches then males/nearly 2 x many females have headaches caused by foodstuffs than males/headaches caused by dehydration similar numbers for males and females

Stress headaches most common males/females/both genders (1) similar numbers for dehydration cause (24) and foodstuffs (23) when male/females considered together (1)

Allow 1 mark for ideas questioning validity of data e.g. cause is a subjective judgement – may be inaccurate/some headaches may be very recent others long time ago – cause therefore less obvious (1) max 6 Allow 4 comparative and 1 most/least point
