

Question 1



Marie is 25 years old and has been diagnosed with multiple sclerosis. She has started to experience blurred vision. Give **four** other signs or symptoms of multiple sclerosis. *(4 marks)*



0 3 Explain how the symptoms of multiple sclerosis are caused. (4 marks)

Marie is in the process of adjusting to living with multiple sclerosis. She works as an accountant and her employer has been very flexible by reducing her hours and allowing her to work from home. She lives with her partner James who works full-time.

0 4 Name **two** psychological life quality factors which Marie is likely to lack as a result of the multiple sclerosis, either in her current situation or in the future. Briefly explain why these factors may be lacking and how they could be provided. *(8 marks)*

0 5	Name two tests used to diagnose disability conditions before birth. For each outline the procedure and state one condition which can be detected.	test, (8 marks)
0 6	Name two disability conditions present at birth which are caused entirely by g factors.	jenetic (2 <i>marks)</i>
0 7	Name one disability condition caused by birth trauma.	(1 mark)
0 8	Describe three methods of reducing the incidence of genetic disorders.	(9 marks)

Question 3



Give **four** common signs and symptoms of cystic fibrosis. (4 marks)



Suggest **two** practitioners likely to be involved in the care of someone with cystic fibrosis and briefly outline their role. (6 marks)

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Maddie is 15 years old and has cystic fibrosis. She has recently moved area to a different mainstream school. Maddie would prefer that students were not informed about her disability. The relevant staff meet to discuss the implications for the school and the kind of provision required.

Discuss what provision a mainstream school should make for a student with cystic fibrosis and refer to possible reasons why Maddie might not wish students to know about her disability.

Question 4



Mary has osteoarthritis. Suggest **three** daily living tasks which she is likely to find difficult and **three** different aids or adaptations to help her overcome these difficulties. *(6 marks)*



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3 Name two physical life quality factors which will improve for Mary as a result of those aids and adaptations. (2 marks)

4 Discuss the extent to which government legislation has improved the quality of life for people with disabilities. Refer to **two** relevant Acts in your answer. The quality of written communication will be assessed in this question. (12 marks)
