1 Archaic, Classical and Hellenistic Greece and its Colonies

Give an account of the Classical Greek orders with reference to specific examples. In what ways do they differ from each other?

2 Rome and its Empire

What are the principal characteristics of Roman portrait sculpture? Answer with reference to specific examples. (20 marks)

3 Early Christian and Byzantine

With reference to specific examples, discuss the architectural characteristics of some Early Christian and/or Byzantine churches. (20 marks)

4 Romanesque

Characterise the style of Romanesque church architecture with reference to specific examples.

(20 marks)

5 Gothic

Compare and contrast **two** Gothic cathedrals, each one from a different country in Europe.

(20 marks)

6 Medieval

With reference to specific examples, compare and contrast the painting of Giotto and Duccio.

(20 marks)

7 15th Century Florence

With reference to specific examples, characterise the style of Florentine Renaissance architecture.

(20 marks)

8 15th Century Italy (excluding Florence)

How and why were light **and** colour important for Venetian painting c.1450–c.1500? Answer with reference to specific examples. (20 marks)

9 Northern Europe

What are the main characteristics of Flemish portraiture between c.1400 and c.1500? Answer with reference to specific examples. (20 marks)

10 High Renaissance in Italy

What are the principal features of High Renaissance sculpture? Answer with reference to specific examples. (20 marks)
